The type of work offered will depend on your qualifications and experience, and the fee will depend on the work offered.

You will need to have a Basic DBS certificate dated from within the previous 12 months before being offered work. If you don't have this, we can advise you how to acquire it. You will also be asked to supply references.

A qualified translator/interpreter will hold a degree or higher in the target language with a translation/interpreting focus OR any degree and a L3/L6 community interpreter award. Some work is only available to holders of a DPSI or membership of professional bodies. However, we also have work for unqualified fluent bilinguals to work on community projects and to meet rare language requirements.

Our rates of pay are good, and dependent on the nature of the work and your qualifications.
